Content:

Abstracts or outline may contain:

- Background/objectives
- Methods/Results
- Conclusion

General Information:

In order to standardize the poster layout presentation we ask you to please print your poster based on the following size:

Portrait, size A0 (high = 1189 x wide = 841)

Poster boards (size 2.25m high x 1.00m wide) and velcros will be offered.

Submitters/Presenters are responsible to print and affixed it on the poster panel mentioned above before the Conference starts (9:00).

Submitters/presenters are free on aspects related to number of words, font size, design and pictures.

Participants are allowed to submit more than one abstract/poster.

Submitter/Presenters are responsible for dismantle of posters. Posters may be removed at the end of the last afternoon coffee break (about 16:00). After closing the Conference (17:00), posters left remaining may be discarded and are not on the responsibility of the Organiser or the venue.

If more than 15 poster presentations, Poster will be evaluated by the judges during the Conference and the winner will be announced at the end of the Conference.

No oral presentations will happen, but we encourage you to be available during breaks and lunch to provide assistance to the audience about your poster.

Poster session will happen at the Exhibition Hall where breaks & lunch will be served and a Graviton staff will provide assistance in case you need it.
